CUPA Immersion

During a single semester or a full academic year, students enrolled in CUPA's immersion can hone their French skills with personalized tutoring and discover multiple aspects of Parisian life while taking program-run courses entirely taught in French and/or direct-matriculation university classes (for students who test at the B2 level required by French universities). They may also engage in independent research projects or develop a more specialized program of study.

CUPA offers a stimulating six-week program in Paris providing intensive work in French language, a selection of content courses, exciting co-curricular and extracurricular activities and permanent contact with the French language and culture. 

Language immersion is at the heart of CUPA's mission. CUPA students take a language placement test upon submission of their application. During their semester or a full academic year, based on their test result, students may take a full load of program-run courses (B1 level required), a combination of program-run and university classes (B2 level required) or a full load of direct-matriculation university classes (B2 level required). If approved by their home university, students may also engage in independent research projects.

The extensive opportunities made available through CUPA, including but not limited to individualized linguistic support, methodology training and cultural activities, facilitate the pursuit of each students' interests and personal goals. As all program-sponsored cultural activities are optional, students are free to choose their own level of extracurricular involvement.

CUPA Immersion

Applications are considered for acceptance as they are received. Applying early is highly recommended.

March 15, 2026: deadline for Fall 2026 semester / Year 2026/2027 applicants.

October 1, 2025: deadline for Spring 2026 semester applicants.

Via our online application form, students provide the required information to review their candidacy. Fill in this form carefully and completely. Please note that you can save your application while in progress, and return to finish it later.

As part of the online application, you will be asked to submit a variety of additional materials (personal statement, ID photos, etc.) and are required to take a language placement test in order to determine the <u>type</u> of courses you can take. 

Application Instructions

Please read these instructions carefully, as well as the instructions in each section.

Complete the information on each page of this application, preferably sequentially. If you are not prepared to complete your application in one sitting, you can close and return to it via the Application Management page.

Once you are ready to submit your application, review and sign it. When you click submit you will be required to pay a \$50 (USD) application fee. You will then have access to your Applicant Status Portal via which you can review requirements, upload additional materials and receive updates on your application.

After submission and payment, you will receive an email from our Language Coordinator with a link and instructions to an online French language placement test. The placement test helps us to direct you to the most appropriate curricular options (i.e., program-run courses, direct matriculation courses or a combination of both). Test results are final, and retesting is not permitted so make sure that you are in a quiet spot with reliable WiFi where you will not be interrupted. YOU MUST COMPLETE THE TEST ON YOUR OWN (no use of translation or Al tools, or assistance from anyone else) within 3 days of receiving the link.

In order for CUPA to review your application and make an admissions decision, you will need to **take your language test** and make sure all of the following have been submitted:

- Transcript
- Short essay in French
- French language recommender
- Study Abroad office contact
- ID-style photo
- Photo of passport


While it is advised to upload these before submitting your application, these materials may be uploaded via your Applicant Status Portal after submission. You will be able to see which materials are still missing in your Status Portal. Your application is not considered complete and will not be reviewed until all pieces of your application are received. All pieces of your application (aside from the language test) must be received by the application deadline, including your recommendatins. Late submissions will be considered only on a space available basis. Plan accordingly.

Study Proposal

As part of the application you will be taking a French language placement test. After submission of your application and payment of the \$50 application fee, you will receive an email from our Language Coordinator with information and instructions about the test. **Test results are final and retesting is not permitted**, so make sure you are in a quiet spot with reliable WiFi where you will not be interrupted.

Based on your result you will have the following options:

<u>Test Result</u> <u>Options</u>

B1, B1+, B2- Full load of program-run courses (taught in French)*

B2 or above Combination of program-run + university classes (taught in French)**

B2 or above Full load of direct-matriculation university classes (taught in French)**

*A score of B1- will be considered on a case-by-case basis only, but is generally not adequate for admission to the program.

**To get an overview of courses that have been offered in the past at CUPA's partner universities, you can consult Former Fall Course Offerings or Former Spring Course Offerings. N.B.: Course offerings and schedules are modified from semester to semester. Students should not assume that a particular course will be offered next term, nor can we guarantee a specific class will be available.

Regardless of your placement test result (B1 or above), you may take one studio art class as part of your full load under the express condition that your home university grants credit for it. Studio majors (dance, art, music) may take a full load of studio courses.

Again, your options will depend on your placement test result. Final course selection takes place in Paris, but you should list specific requirements and the types of courses or subjects that interest you. For certain areas of study (ex. STEM, another foreign language, directed research, applied arts, dance and music), you will be required to provide additional information or documentation in the Special Areas of Study section.

It is your responsibility to be aware of your home institution's credit requirements.

Financial Assistance

CUPA believes that study abroad is an enriching and essential part of an undergraduate education. It can also be expensive. For students whose home schools can not or do not release institutional financial aid to study abroad, CUPA may be able to help defray some the burden of these costs.

To be eligible you must submit proof of your home institution's Financial Aid package, including all awards, grants, loans, work study, etc., as well as the expected yearly/semester family contribution.

- Summer students: You must also submit a letter explaining your current financial situation, and whether you are expecting outside awards/scholarships.
- Semester/Year students: You are encouraged to submit any additional documentation you feel
 would be helpful for the financial assistance committee to better understand your unique
 situation.CUPA aid funds are limited, and we cannot guarantee to match your home school financial
 aid package. To receive the best possible package you should apply for CUPA financial assistance as
 soon as you have submitted your application for admission.

*CUPA financial assistance can only be considered for students whose home schools can not, or do not, release institutional financial aid to study abroad.

Passport Scan

It is important for CUPA to have proof of your current citizenship(s) in order to pre-register for classes and to determine eligibility requirements* for a French student visa. If your passport expires within three months of your expected departure from France, then you must renew it now. If you do not have a current and valid passport, you must apply for one immediately as it can take between 5 and 12 weeks to process.

*While EU citizens are exempt from applying for a French student visa, possession of a current and valid passport is still required for entry to France and for registration in Paris universities. You must still upload a copy of your EU passport.


