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## Application Instructions

This is the application for the CUPA French Language Immersion Program in Paris. Please read these instructions carefully, along with the instructions provided in each section of the application.

Please complete each page of this application, preferably in order. If you are unable to finish your application in one sitting, you can save your progress at any time and return to it later via the Application Management page.

Once you are ready to submit your application, please review and sign it, and submit the nonrefundable \$50 USD application fee. We encourage students to submit their application and payment even if some supporting materials (e.g. professor recommendations) are still pending.

Once your application and payment have been submitted, you will gain access to your Applicant Status Portal, where you can:

- Review outstanding application requirements
- Upload additional materials
- Track your application status
- Receive admission decision updates

Submission and payment also lets us know that you are ready to be sent the required French language placement test.

You will receive an email from our French Language Coordinator with a link and instructions to take an online French language placement test. The placement test helps us to determine the most appropriate course placement for you, including CUPA-run courses (at the CUPA study center or CUPA satellite campus), direct matriculation courses (courses taken at a French University), or a combination of both.

Please note the following requirements for the placement test:

- The test must be completed by the deadline provided in your instructions email.
- You must complete the test independently. The use of translation tools, AI tools, or assistance from others is strictly prohibited.
- Please complete the test in a quiet environment with reliable internet access where you will not be interrupted.

If desired, students may meet with a CUPA French Language Coordinator to discuss the test before completing it. Test results are considered final and retesting is generally not permitted - placement petitions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

To be considered for CUPA admission, you must complete the placement test and ensure that all required application materials are submitted:

- Transcript
- Short essay in French
- French language recommender
- Study Abroad office contact
- ID-style photo
- Photo of passport

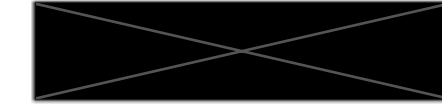
Your application is not considered complete and will not be reviewed until all pieces of your application are received.

While you may upload these materials before submitting your application, they can also be uploaded afterward through your Applicant Status Portal. The portal will indicate which materials are still missing. **All pieces of your application must be received by the application deadline (unless otherwise specified).** Late application submissions will be considered only on a space available basis. Please plan accordingly.

If you are in need of emergency medical care, hospitalization, or surgery while participating in the CUPA program, you authorize CUPA, through its representatives, to secure any necessary treatment and to notify the emergency contact(s) listed below.

International Health Insurance

If you are admitted to the CUPA program, you will be automatically enrolled in an international health insurance plan for the term(s) you attend. This plan, administered by Blue Cross Blue Shield Global Solutions (BCBSGS), is valid for international use and is active from the start date of the program through the end date. The CUPA BCBSGS plan is automatic and cannot be waived through CUPA.

We are providing this information at the application stage so that you have time to review your home college or university's health insurance policies. Some institutions have their own health insurance waiver or exemption processes, and you may wish to consult with your home school to determine whether any action is required on your part.

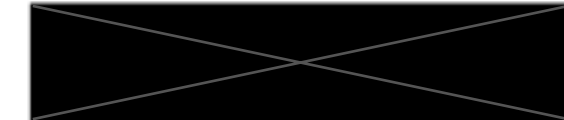

\*\*Applicants who score a B2- may also be eligible to petition for a maximum of 2 direct-matriculation French university classes. This is evaluated on a per-student basis.

\*\*\*For detailed academic planning, please reach out to [cupa@cupa-paris.edu](mailto:cupa@cupa-paris.edu), prior to submitting your application. After admission to the program, the CURA team will send an individualized PDF with a selection of available courses for each applicant to choose from. This information will be tailored based on your academic needs provided within.

To get a sense of courses that have been offered in the past at CURA's partner universities, you can consult Former Fall Course Offerings or Former Spring Course Offerings. N.B.: Course offerings and schedules are modified from semester to semester. Students should not assume that a particular course will be offered next term; nor can we guarantee a specific class will be available.

Regardless of your placement test result (B1 or above), you may take one studio art class as part of your full load under the express condition that your home university grants credit for it. Studio majors (dance, art, music) may take a full load of studio courses.

Again, your options will depend on your placement test result. Final course selection takes place in Paris, but you should list specific requirements and the types of courses or subjects that interest you. For certain areas of study (ex. STEM, another foreign language, directed research, applied arts, dance and music), you will be required to provide additional information or documentation in the Special Areas of Study section.

It is your responsibility to be aware of your home institution's credit requirements.

This form confirms that you are in good academic and disciplinary standing at your home college or university and are eligible to participate in study abroad.

**French Department Recommendation Form:** All applicants must submit a French Department Recommendation Form, even if they have not taken a French course at their current college or university. If this applies to you, we recommend meeting with a member of your institution's French faculty who can evaluate your language background and complete the form.

**Please note:** Your recommendation forms are not required by the application deadline, but should be received shortly after. We encourage students to request them as early as possible to avoid delays. You are welcome to submit your application before the forms are received; however, **CUPA cannot fully review or render an admissions decision until all recommendation forms have been submitted.**

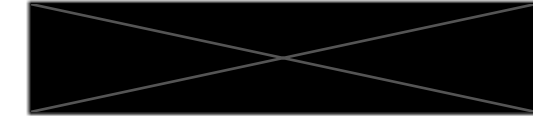

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## Financial Assistance

CUPA believes that study abroad is an enriching and essential part of an undergraduate education. It can also be expensive. For students whose home schools can not or do not release institutional financial aid to study abroad, CUPA may be able to help defray some the burden of these costs.

To be eligible you must submit proof of your home institution's Financial Aid package, including all awards, grants, loans, work study, etc., as well as the expected yearly/semester family contribution.

- **Summer students:** You must also submit a letter explaining your current financial situation, and whether you are expecting outside awards/scholarships.
- **Semester/Year students:** You are encouraged to submit any additional documentation you feel would be helpful for the financial assistance committee to better understand your unique situation. CUPA aid funds are limited, and we cannot guarantee to match your home school financial aid package. To receive the best possible package you should apply for CUPA financial assistance as soon as you have submitted your application for admission.
